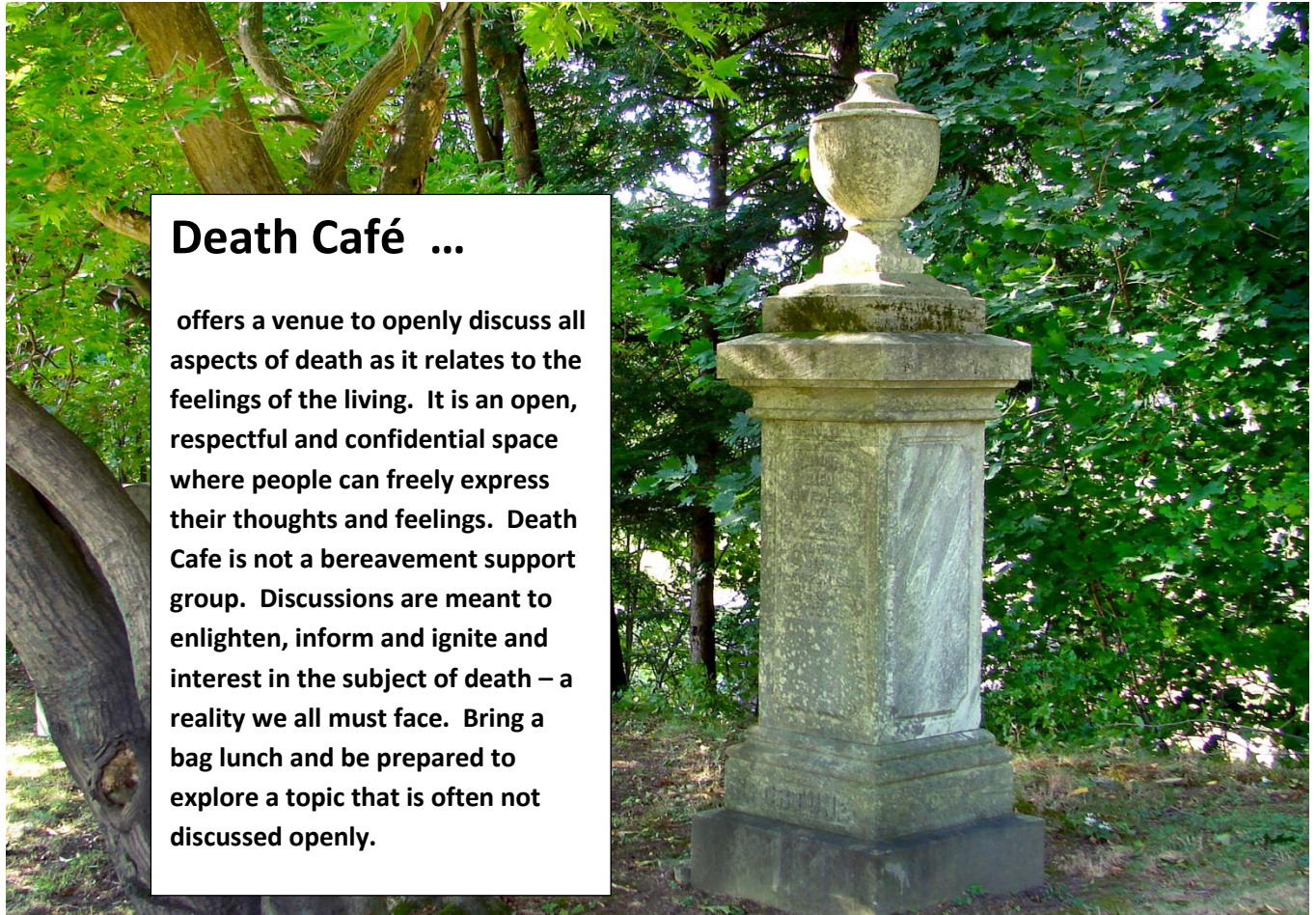


Death Café
