Anne A. Feth, age 106, formerly of Bethany Village in Coxsackie, passed away on Friday, January 15, 2021, at Greene Meadows Nursing Home in Catskill, due to complications of COVID-19. She was born on May 14, 1914, and was the daughter of the late Joseph and Elizabeth Weixl of Wakaw, Sask. and was the oldest of four children. Anne attended a one room schoolhouse from age seven through 17. She met fellow Canadian Ignatius "Rex" Feth and they married in 1934 and moved to the U.S. and became U.S. citizens. Anne and Rex lived in many areas in their 69 years together including Salem, Selkirk, Hannacroix, Coxsackie and Greenville. Together they raised three children, Margaret (Albert) Matter, George (Davida) Feth and Dorothy (Douglas) McCarty. Anne was a homemaker most of her life and took good care of her family. She was known for always making homemade goodies for her family friends, relatives, neighbors and neighborhood children. Anne did not receive her driver's license until the age of 72 and she worked outside of her home at The Betty Jean Dress Factory in Coxsackie for five years. She loved going on Sunday rides and traveling to Saskatchewan to see family. She loved playing piano and was a member of St. Mary's Church in Coxsackie and The National Grange into her 90's. Besides her children, she is survived by three grandchildren, Douglas, Brenda and Jonathan; three great-grandchildren, Matthew, Lauren and Andrew; one great-great-grandchild Joseph; her sister Daisy; and many nephews and nieces. Besides her parents, Anne was predeceased by her husband "Rex"; her brothers, Ernie and Louie; and sons-in-law, Albert Matter and Douglas McCarty.
